☆ **Australian Sports Commission – Sporting Schools Program**

Overview

This program aims to help schools increase children's participation and opportunities in sport.

The program has two levels of funding:

1. Primary
 - Helps to provide a range of sporting programs that will increase children's interest and participation in sport. It also aims to create stronger links between children and local sporting clubs, nurturing a lifelong love of sport.
 - Funding includes a base amount determined by the whole school enrolment, plus an amount for the expected overall participant numbers.
 - Special circumstances funding is also available to assist schools with additional costs due to location or demographics. Funding amounts are usually between \$1,000 and \$3,600 per term.
2. Secondary
 - There are three key goals for secondary schools:
 - a) Tackle the decline in sports participation that occurs during adolescence.
 - b) Increase physical activity in areas with large cohorts of inactive students.

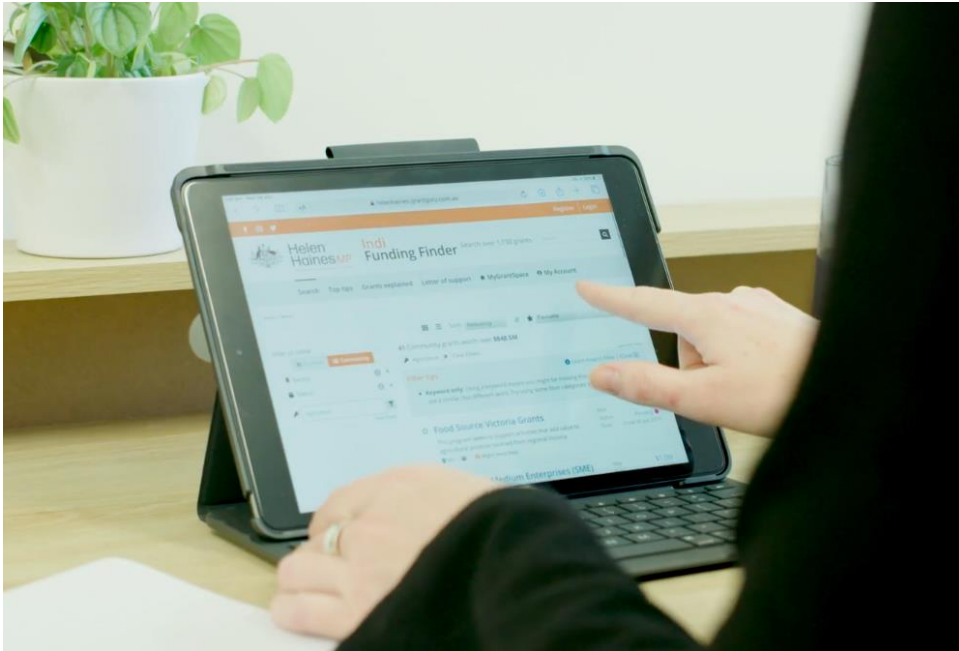
